

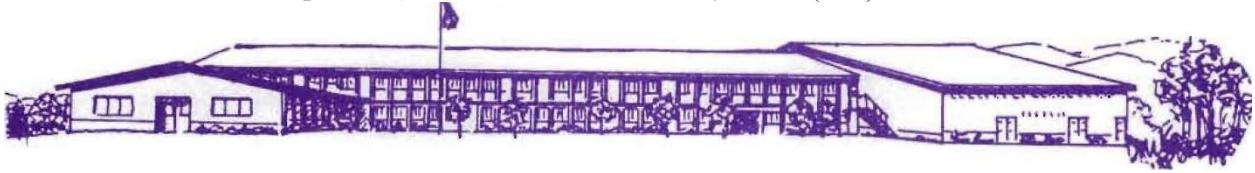

### **STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT REVIEWS CAFETERIA**

Congratulations to the entire cafeteria staff for a very positive review from the State Education Department (SED). The SED team was at MCS the entire day on Thursday, and they spoke well of the entire MCS Cafeteria team! Way to go!

### **CLASS OF 2019 CHINESE AUCTION**

On Saturday, the Class of 2019 will hold their Chinese Auction. The doors will open at 10AM, and the auction itself will begin at 1PM. This is a major fundraiser for the senior class, and I hope that we can all show them our support.

### **CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATE**

We continue to work toward preparing for the Capital Project vote on December 11th. As a reminder, there will be **NO ADDITIONAL TAX BURDEN** in order for our District to complete this \$4.69 million project.

Last Friday, our team met with the architects and our construction manager to review the architectural drawings. This review included the mechanical engineer's analysis of our HVAC system and plumbing in the main office area. His review indicated that our current HVAC system is highly inefficient and that many of the components are at "end-of-life". If approved by voters, these systems will be replaced, and we will benefit from a much more energy efficient system.
