

- SED approved Phase 1 of our project and issued our building permit this past week.
- Phase 1 work went out for bid early this week. The deadline for bids is May 2nd, and a pre-bid walkthrough will occur on 4/23 at 1:30 PM.
- Last week the Facilities Committee met with the architects to select finishes for Phase 1. This included selecting paint colors, carpeting, furniture, as well as tiling options for the lobby and bathroom floors.


